# River Walk Window Art

### Materials Needed:

- Objects found on your river walk like: leaves, sticks, flowers, grass etc...
- small plastic bag
- safety scissors
- clear contact paper
- colored ribbon
- help from mom or dad or your teacher



### Step #1

The next time that you and your friends are exploring the areas around a river, look on the ground and select what you think would be nice objects to remember your trip. Select these items and place them in the plastic bag.

*Rae Rae "Tip:" Remember boys and girls, never ever go near any body of water like a river, lake or ocean unless you are with a responsible adult.*

### Step #2

On a flat surface like a table or desk lay out the objects you collected on your trip.

### Step#3

Have mom, dad or your teacher cut out two circles out of the clear contact paper

### Step #4

Place the collected items on the sticky side of the contact paper and place the second pick of contact paper on top of the items, than press them together to seal them

### Step #6

Have mom, dad, or your teacher cut a hole in the top of the circle and hang it in the window with a pick of ribbon, yarn, or string.
